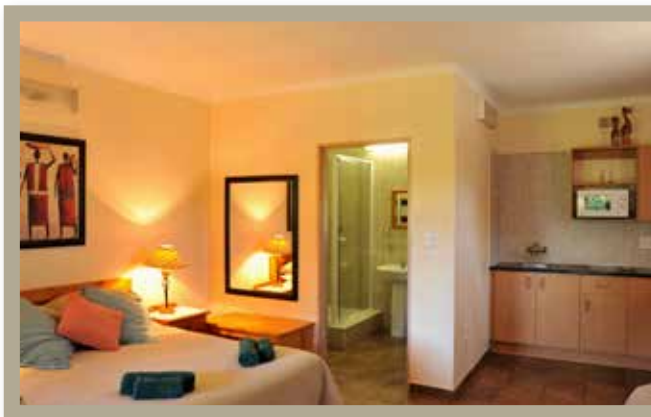


SA BASS PRESENTS FISHING DESTINATIONS

Komati River Chalets

Komati River Chalets is nestled on the confluence of the Komati and Crocodile Rivers in the Southern Kruger Park region of Mpumalanga's wild frontier. Situated on 12 acres of Komati river front wilderness ensures that this is one of the regions premier country estates.

The Komati River is home to numerous species of fresh water fish. The most famous of these species is the tiger fish. There are various well positioned spots all along the river front on the property for keen anglers! Guided boat fishing is also available.

Other species that can be caught from the property are Mozambique bream (blue kurper), red breasted bream, mudfish, catfish and carp. There is also some good bass fishing to be had in many of the private farm dams in the area.

The famous Kruger National Park, Crocodile bridge gate is a mere 12km from the lodge and the sweet veld grasses of the South Eastern Kruger National Park ensure

that this is arguably the best game viewing area of the entire park as vast herds of plains game and predators alike are attracted to the spoils of this pristine area.

Both Mozambique and Swaziland are but a stone throw from Komati River Chalets providing the perfect base from which to explore both exotic destinations.

Set above the flood plain of the Komati River, the restaurant, bar and pool facilities, and the individual chalets are no more than fifty metres from the water's edge where pods of hippos and an array of spectacular bird life will entertain for hours on end.

The attention to detail and hands on management style of this family owned property ensure that Komati River Chalets is the ideal destination for the adventurous traveller.
